Didactic Sessions (80 minutes)

Time	Topic	Key Points
20 min	Principle of using intestinal segment in the urology reconstruction	Basic understanding on how to isolate apart of intestine with preserved blood supply for use in the diversion and principle of reanastomosis and how to avoid complication.
20 min	Choice of type of urinary diversion according to the patient situation	Updated about how to choose between different types of diversion according to the patient, kidney and tumour characteristics.
20 min	Benign uses of urinary diversion	Explained benign indication of diversion as augmentation cystoplasty and different techniques of use of intestine in ureteric substitution.
20 min	Techniques of different types of urinary pouches and ileal loop conduit	Different techniques used for the construction of pouches used for bladder substitutions and types of uretero-intestinal anastomosis, in addition to the technique of ileal loop conduit
